

TRAINING ON THE ENVIRONMENT/CLIMATE CHANGE HELD IN SWEDEN

A training session entitled „ Integration of Environment/Climate Change“ was held in Harnosand, Sweden from 3 to 5 May 2017 within the CILAP project (Capacity building for Improvement of Land Administration and Procedures in BiH).
